

## Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency Brownfields Assessment Grant Site Nomination Form

In 2022, the Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency (MIRA) was awarded an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfields Assessment Grant. The EPA defines a brownfield as a real property, the expansion, redevelopment, or reuse of which may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant, or contaminant. Brownfield properties are vast in nature; examples include former gasoline stations, historic properties, automobile service and repair shops, dry cleaning facilities, industrial facilities, warehouses, landfills, dumps, and more.

Eligible grant funded activities include Phase I & II Environmental Site Assessments, cleanup planning, site reuse planning, site inventory and prioritization, community engagement, technical assistance, and more.

To nominate a site for an eligible grant-funded activity, please fill in the blanks below, using "Unknown," "None," or "Not Applicable" where necessary. You do not need to be the site owner or purchaser to nominate a site. Nominating a site does not guarantee the site will receive grant funding. Sites will be scored on the criteria below. A Site Access Permission Form must be signed by the property owner prior to initiation of grant work.
