III.B 329 Hibiscus Office and Storage Structure Site Plan:

In attendance for this item was Scott and Carol Raab, Curt McKinney and Frank Plata, Plata Engineering. Mr. McKinney shared this project is a preliminary site plan for a metal building. Mr. McKinney continued their meeting with the County concluded the metal building was permissible in the Merritt Island area. The Board entered a lengthy discussion on metal buildings and how MIRA does not want metal buildings in the MIRA District. Mr. McKinney indicated the owners, the Raab's, are not seeking a business license as the building is for personal car collection restorations done by Mr. Raab and storage of the cars. Mr. McKinney continued there is an issue as the Brevard County Fire Department is adamant about installing a fire hydrant which is very expensive. Attorney Caron addressed the Board that this site plan will go through the Planning & Development Dept. and their codes.

III.A Boeteka Fence Variance Review – 23V0043, 1775 E. Merritt Island Causeway:

The owner is TGAC Real Estate, and the property is in BU2 zoning. The applicant is requesting that an 8-foot fence be permitted, only along the westside of the property within the site to create a sense of separation from the business and adjacent pedestrian pathways along the roadway, and to allow for additional site security. This request will move on to the Board of Adjustment. After reviewing the site plan, the MIRA Board discussed the height of the fence and the different types of fencing. The Board agreed to liking the change.
